



# Reentry Case Management Services

## Get support to access your reentry health services

Your Apple Health (Medicaid) health insurance through Washington State includes case management services to help you prepare for life after your release date.

If you are not enrolled in a managed care plan for your Apple Health coverage, Community Health Partnership Services (CHPS) can be your reentry case management provider.

**To support you during your transition, CHPS Reentry Case Managers can help you with:**

- **Appointments:** Scheduling visits for medical, dental, and vision care.
- **Recovery:** Connecting to mental health care and substance use disorder treatment.
- **Housing:** Getting housing referrals and locating housing support programs.
- **Food, transportation, job search:** Finding community resources that offer support.
- **Reentry goals:** Staying on track with regular check-ins.

Your reentry case manager works with you as early as 90 days before your expected release date and usually up to 30 days after. During that time, they can find and refer you to health care providers and other community-based social services that best fit your long-term goals and needs.



## Sign up for Reentry Case Management

Reentry case management is optional, but with limited time to access your reentry health services, it can make a big difference for your overall health and well-being.
